1. Key Scripture Reflection

Read and reflect on the following verses:

- Genesis 1:26-28
- Genesis 2:15
- Colossians 3:23-24

Prompt:

What is God showing you through these verses about the nature and purpose of work?

2. Key Takeaway

Prompt:

What stood out to you most during this session? Why?

3. Personal Insight

Prompt:

Did this session challenge any beliefs or assumptions you've held about work?

4. Application Question

Prompt:

How will you shift your mindset this week to see your job as sacred work?

5. Prayer Response

Prompt:

Write a short prayer, dedicating your work to God and asking Him to reveal His purpose in your daily labor.

Prompt:

One practical way I will live out the divine purpose of work this week is:

Session 2: Work Before and After the Fall

1. Key Scripture Reflection

Read and reflect on the following verses:

- Genesis 2:15
- Genesis 3:17-19
- Romans 8:20-21

Prompt:

What do these verses reveal about how sin has affected work and how God is redeeming it?

2. Key Takeaway

Prompt:

What insight or truth from this session made the biggest impact on you?

3. Personal Insight

Prompt:

Have you experienced frustration or pain in your work? How might those moments be connected to the effects of the Fall?

4. Application Question

Prompt:

Where do you see God at work redeeming broken areas of your job or career path?

5. Prayer Response

Prompt:

Write a prayer asking God to help you respond to the frustrations of work with faith and hope.

Prompt:

One specific way I will invite God into a difficult area of work this week is:

Session 3: God as the Ultimate Employer

1. Key Scripture Reflection

Read and reflect on the following verses:

- Psalm 24:1
- Colossians 3:23-24
- Proverbs 16:3

Prompt:

How does seeing God as your ultimate employer change the way you approach your work?

2. Key Takeaway

Prompt:

What truth from this session encouraged or convicted you the most?

3. Personal Insight

Prompt:

Do you find yourself working for human approval? How does that affect your motivation and peace?

4. Application Question

Prompt:

How can you practically remind yourself each day that you are working for the Lord?

5. Prayer Response

Prompt:

Write a prayer offering your work to God and asking Him to guide your efforts and mindset.

Prompt:

One specific way I will act like God is my boss this week is:

Session 4: Stewardship and Responsibility

1. Key Scripture Reflection

Read and reflect on the following verses:

- 1 Peter 4:10
- Proverbs 16:3
- Luke 16:10

Prompt:

What do these Scriptures teach you about being a steward of your time, talents, and resources?

2. Key Takeaway

Prompt:

What principle from this session most challenged or encouraged you?

3. Personal Insight

Prompt:

Where have you struggled to see yourself as a steward rather than an owner? Why?

4. Application Question

Prompt:

What area of your life or work do you feel God is asking you to manage more faithfully?

5. Prayer Response

Prompt:

Write a prayer of surrender and commitment, asking God to help you steward what He has entrusted to you.

One action I will take this week to better steward my responsibilities is:

Session 5: Rest and Work - A Holy Balance

1. Key Scripture Reflection

Read and reflect on the following verses:

- Exodus 20:8-10
- Mark 2:27
- Psalm 127:2

Prompt:

What do these Scriptures reveal about God's design for rest in the rhythm of life and work?

2. Key Takeaway

Prompt:

What insight from this session most impacted the way you think about rest?

3. Personal Insight

Prompt:

Do you struggle with rest? Why or why not?

4. Application Question

Prompt:

What's one change you can make this week to honor God's gift of Sabbath or regular rest?

5. Prayer Response

Prompt:

Write a prayer asking God to help you rest well, trust Him more, and release the pressure to overwork.

Prompt:

One intentional rest habit I will try this week is:

Session 6: Work as Worship

1. Key Scripture Reflection

Read and reflect on the following verses:

- Colossians 3:23–24
- Romans 12:1
- 1 Corinthians 10:31

Prompt:

How do these verses expand your understanding of worship through your work?

2. Key Takeaway

Prompt:

What idea or truth from this session most inspired you?

3. Personal Insight

Prompt:

What areas of your work have you seen as 'less spiritual'? How might God view those tasks differently?

4. Application Question

Prompt:

What is one way you can intentionally make your work an act of worship this week?

5. Prayer Response

Prompt:

Write a prayer offering your daily work to God as a living sacrifice and act of worship.

One practical step I will take to treat my work as worship is:

Session 7: Work and the Great Commission

1. Key Scripture Reflection

Read and reflect on the following verses:

- Matthew 5:14–16
- 2 Corinthians 5:20
- Matthew 28:19–20

Prompt:

What do these verses show you about your role in God's mission at work?

2. Key Takeaway

Prompt:

What was the most encouraging or eye-opening truth from this session?

3. Personal Insight

Prompt:

How does knowing you are Christ's ambassador change how you approach your coworkers or customers?

4. Application Question

Prompt:

Who is one person in your workplace you can begin praying for or reaching out to this week?

5. Prayer Response

Prompt:

Write a prayer asking God to use you as a light in your workplace and to open doors for gospel influence.

Session 8: Man and God in Business

1. Key Scripture Reflection

Read and reflect on the following verses:

- Deuteronomy 8:18
- Matthew 6:24
- Proverbs 16:3

Prompt:

2. Key Takeaway

Prompt:

What truth from this session most reshaped your thinking about business and faith?

3. Personal Insight

Prompt:

What tension do you experience between spiritual values and business goals?

4. Application Question

Prompt:

What would it look like to honor God more intentionally in a current business or work decision?

5. Prayer Response

Prompt:

Write a prayer dedicating your business or work to the Lord, asking for wisdom and integrity.

Session 9: Finding Purpose in Rejection

1. Key Scripture Reflection

Read and reflect on the following verses:

- Isaiah 41:9–10
- Romans 8:28
- John 15:18–19

Prompt:

What encouragement do you find in these verses when facing rejection or setbacks?

2. Key Takeaway

Prompt:

What insight from this session helped you view rejection differently?

3. Personal Insight

Prompt:

Have you experienced rejection in your work or calling? How did you respond, and what did you learn?

4. Application Question

Prompt:

Where might God be using a closed door or difficult season to redirect or refine your calling?

5. Prayer Response

Prompt:

Write a prayer of trust, asking God to help you grow through rejection and remain faithful.

One step I will take to trust God with a disappointment or rejection is:

Session 10: The Gift of Inheritance

1. Key Scripture Reflection

Read and reflect on the following verses:

- Colossians 3:24
- Ephesians 1:18
- Matthew 25:21

Prompt:

What do these Scriptures teach you about the eternal rewards of faithfulness in your work?

2. Key Takeaway

Prompt:

What insight from this session most helped you see your work with eternal significance?

3. Personal Insight

Prompt:

What motivates you to keep working faithfully, even when you don't see immediate results?

4. Application Question

Prompt:

How can remembering your eternal inheritance shape your daily attitude and actions?

5. Prayer Response

Prompt:

Write a prayer thanking God for the promise of eternal reward and asking for strength to stay faithful.

1. Key Scripture Reflection

Read and reflect on the following verses:

2. Key Takeaway

Prompt:

What part of this session most helped you find peace in your work life?

3. Personal Insight

Prompt:

What fears or worries do you carry into your workday? How do you usually respond to them?

4. Application Question

Prompt:

What new habit or truth can you lean on to experience greater peace this week?

5. Prayer Response

Prompt:

Write a prayer surrendering your stress and anxieties to God and asking Him for peace and clarity.

What idea from this final session gave you the most hope or renewed purpose?
